

# MEET OUR SPEAKER

Pastor Sequeira ["suh-KWHERE-ah"] was born in Nairobi, Kenya. He joined the Seventh-day Adventist church through evangelism in 1957. Feeling called to the ministry, Jack rode to England from Nairobi on his motorcycle in 1958 and spent 14 months working as a literature evangelist before enrolling at Newbold College (England). He graduated with a B.A. in theology in 1963. He earned an M.A. in systematic theology at Andrews University (Berrien Springs, Michigan, U.S.A.) in 1965. Pastor Sequeira earned his M.Div. at Andrews University in 1970.

Jack and his wife Jean served as missionaries for 17 years in Uganda, Kenya, and Ethiopia. Jack served in various capacities as Bible teacher, departmental director, university chaplain, union ministerial director, and college president.

In 1982, the Sequeiras moved to the United States. Jack served as a pastor for the Kuna and Nampa churches in the Idaho Conference, then as senior pastor of the Walla Walla City Church in Washington State. In 1991, he became senior pastor of the Capital Memorial Church in Washington, D.C. Pastor Jack retired in January 2001 but is still busy ministering to others. He is happy to have a very full schedule of preaching and seminar appointments. Apart from the worldwide ministry opportunities which God supplies, Jack enjoys vegetable gardening and "looking at the fish" in the lakes and rivers of the beautiful Pacific Northwest.


