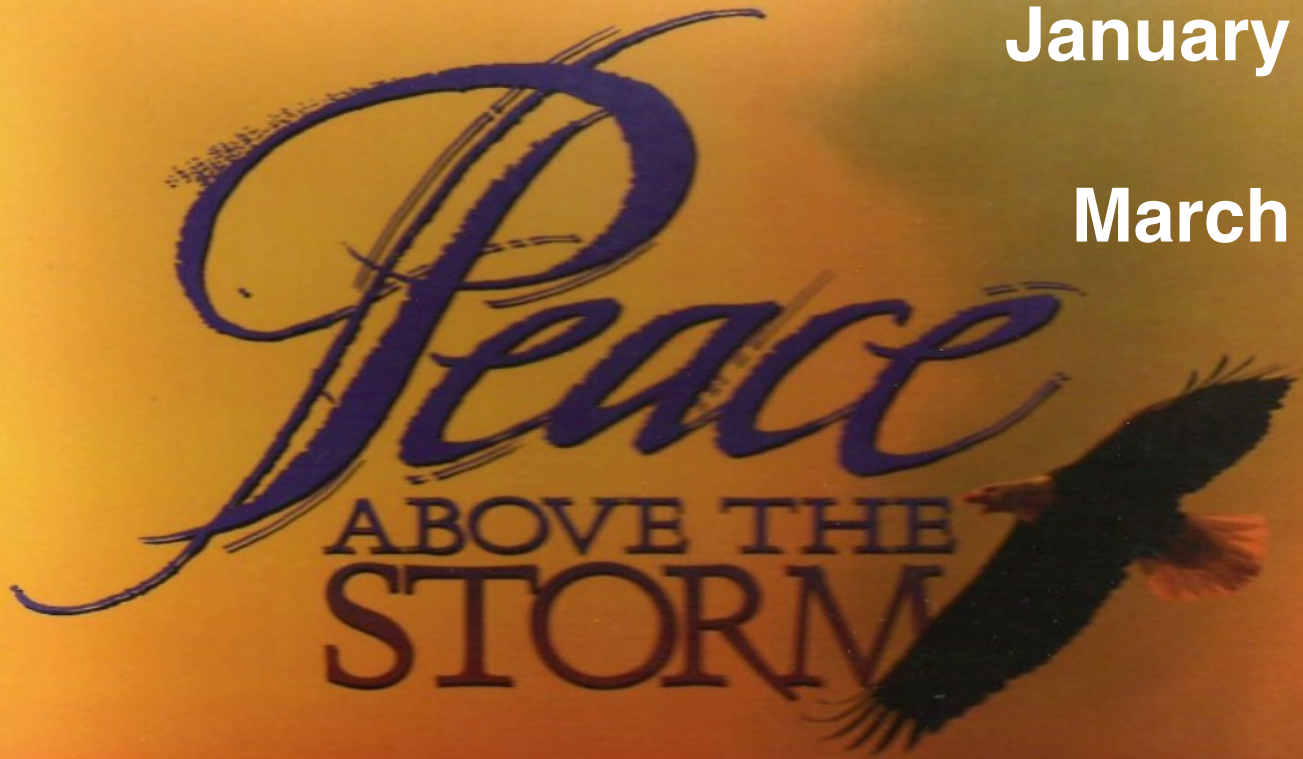

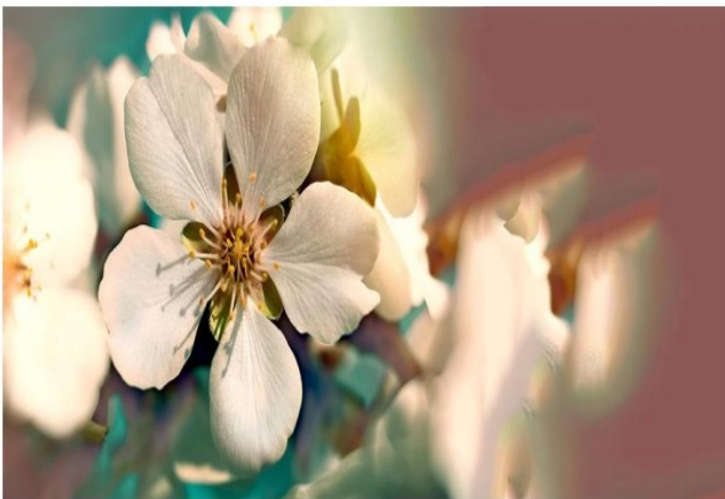

Denetra Gary, LCSW

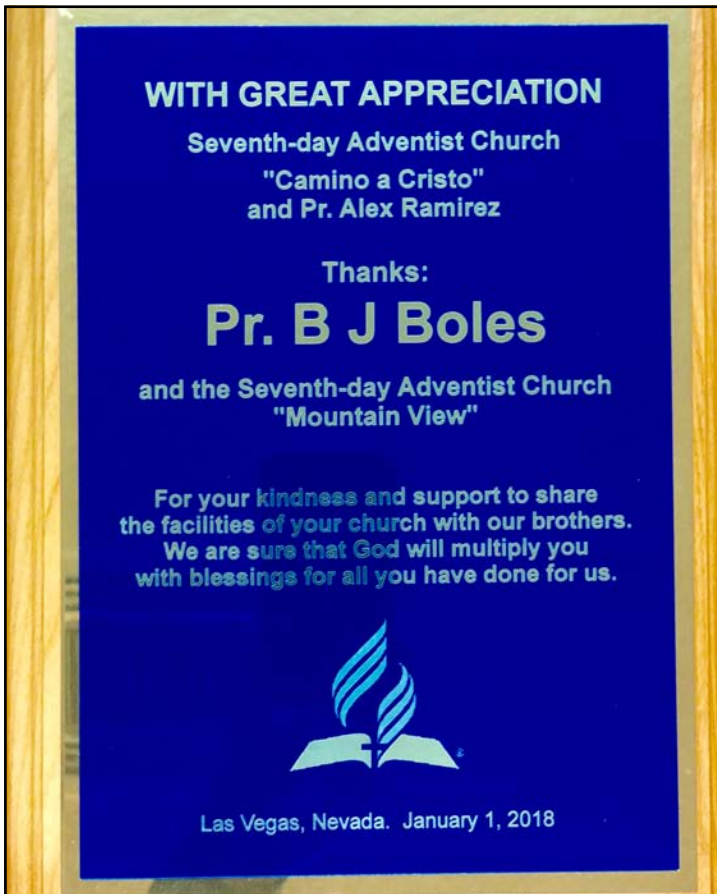

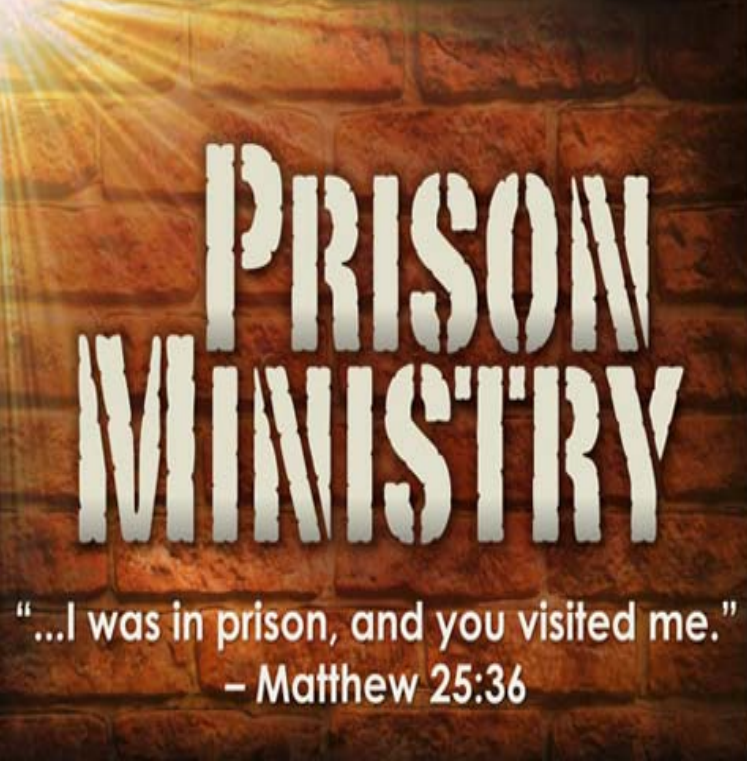

We at the Mountain View Church are planning to begin a new and unique radio, video ministry called "*Light My Path 313*". We desire to launch this innovative outreach approach in 2018 for Las Vegas, Nevada and the world.

"*Light My Path 313*" will be a dynamic radio and TV program to share the Gospel message by recounting the whole incredible Bible story from start to finish. 313 radio programs a year will air six mornings a week at 7:30am on AM 1060, FM 99.9 in Las Vegas. The visitor to the website www.LightMyPath313.com will be able to watch, listen and read each program and there will be links to the corresponding Bible passage and chapter in the Spirit of Prophecy.

Dr. BJ Boles will take people on an incredible journey across the scriptures through his engaging and dynamic storytelling. The goal is to use the radio program and website as a bridge to invite patrons to the Mountain View Church to watch a live filming of Dr. Boles on Saturdays.

"*Light My Path 313*" will be promoted through direct mailers, members inviting friends and billboards to drive commuters to listen to the program during their commute. In the end, we will film 313 sermons which will become 626 radio programs. The proposed four-year project budget is \$136,650.00 to be shared among four groups: The Mountain View Church, the Nevada-Utah Conference, the Pacific Union & private donors.

We invite you to partner with us to make "*Light My Path 313*" and this incredible opportunity possible. Sermons are set to begin in January, 2018 with the launch of the actual ministry waiting for all parties to enter into the covenant with a tentative launch target of late spring 2018 or early summer 2018.
